The school was set up in July 2002 by Wing Commander Anoop Kumar Mehrotra, and his wife Mrs. Priya Mehrotra.





- 11. Indoor and outdoor games for physical and mental fitness.


















Toddlers being the backbone of the future, we emphasize on four principles:-

Selection Procedure

Selection will be made on the basis of an assessment after an informal meeting and interaction with parents and children.





➤ Birth Certificate of the child issued by Municipal Cooperation or certified by Gram Panchayat. OR Aadhar Card. ➤ 3 Passport-size photographs of the child and two separate photographs of parents. Proof of residence of parents.

Documents Required

- Photocopy of report card of last school attended.
- Transfer Certificate from previous school.

Procedure For Admission

- Registration is the first step.
- Submit the form duly filled in the school office along with the document attached with it.
- The date and time is notified at the time of registration."
- > Students are admitted according to the number of seats available in the class.
- All dues are to be paid at the time of admission by cash or demand draft no balance will be accepted.



- 1. All pupils are required to wear the school uniform. Neatness in dress and person should be cultivated by every pupil. Long fingernails, nail polish, jewellery or bringing of expensive articles, fanciful earrings etc., to the school is prohibited.
- 2. The school uniform is compulsory on all school days and school functions. Children who come without school uniforms should bring a note of excuse from their parents.
- 3. All must have at least two pairs of school dress for convenience and to be always clean, neat and tidy.





Recommendations to Farents

- It is compulsory for Parents and students to read all the general information given in the school diary.
- Your ward is required to note down the day-to-day class/homework throughout the year. And you are requested to keep a check on his/her work regularly.
- You may be called upon by the Class Teacher or Subject Teachers of your ward to visit the School by a request made in the diary.
- Parents are NOT allowed to visit the Classrooms or meet the teachers during School hours. Parents are not permitted to sit and note down any classwork or homework during School hours (If the child is present).
- > Private tuition is not encouraged. Parents must not engage teachers of the school as private tutors for their wards at all.
- > Students are required to reach the school at least 10 minutes before the school starts. The school gates will be closed as soon as the assembly starts and students will not be given entry after that.
- English is the medium of instruction in our school. Therefore, it is compulsory for all students and teachers to use English Language for academic work as well as for conversation in the School premises (except in the Hindi class).
- Parents are encouraged to provide their children maximum exposure to English, as far as possible by allowing only viewing of English TV channels, English Newspapers & as far as possible speaking in English at home also.
- Escorts I card should be maintained and carried daily by the person authorized by the parents to drop and pickup the child.
- ➤ Help your child to remember his/her home address and telephone number.
- > Please inform any change in the telephone number or address to the class teacher.
- > Give your child special jobs to do and praise him/her for the same, even if the job is not perfect e.g. setting the dining table putting things in place, packing their bags, changing their clothes, wearing shoes and tying laces etc.
- > "Value education does not happen naturally, you have to make it happen". We therefore will be initiating value-based activities to build up a sound value system. The reinforcement of the same could be done at home.
- > School management committee reserves the right to change/cancel/any rule or rules in the interest of the smooth functioning of the school.

Attendance & Leave



- Attendance will be compulsory on the re-opening day after each holiday.
- > If the child remains absent, parents have to send a leave application and should accompany the child to note down the missed work.
- If a student is absent from school for a period exceeding 10 days without a written application, his/her admission will be cancelled and seat re-allotted to another student.
- Students with names removed from the roll will have to take fresh admission with the Principal's permission.
- > Students are required to put in a minimum attendance of 75% of the total number of working days during the academic session, failing which they would become ineligible for promotion to the next class.
- ➤ Sick leave will be granted on by producing a proper medical certificate.
- Students who have been absent from the class must give the reasons of their absence in their school diary under the column of Absence Record.
- No leave of absence will be granted without a previous application in writing from the Parent/Guardian.
- For marriage in the family only two days leave will be granted.
- > Students failing to abide by this rule expose themselves to disciplinary action.
- All leaves must be applied in writing to the Principal. No student shall proceed on leave without sanction and permission, especially when the leave exceeds one day. Birthdays, excursions, urgent business etc. are not valid reasons for leaves.

Examination & Assessment

- > Students will be assessed on their year round performance and promotion to the next class will be on this basis.
- There will be two 2 U.T (for every subject) in a Year, and two Terminal Exams.
- Marks will be shown to the parents during the Parent Teacher Meeting. Kindly note that the marks secured in these Class tests/Unit Tests will be added to the Grand Total.
- > All Projects and Art/ Craft work along with the Holiday Homework should be duly completed during the holidays and submitted to the Teachers concerned, as soon as the School reopens.
- All promotions are decided only after careful consideration of all aspects of the pupil's progress. Hence the decision of the Principal in this regard is final and binding.
- > Students will not be allowed to sit for the examination until all fees and dues are cleared.
- > An application for the re-test in special cases may be considered, at the discretion of the Principal. In that case school may charge a nominal fee.
