An Adverb is a word that adds something to the meaning of a verb.

An Adverb modifies the meaning of -

A Verb - Aditya runs fast.

fast - modifies the verb 'runs'

An Adjective - These are very beautiful shoes.

very - modifies the adjective 'beautiful'

Another Adverb - The flight will land very soon.

very - modifies the adverb 'soon'

KINDS OF ADVERBS

Adverb of
manner

It tells us how
an action is done.

Eg:- Tom ran
fast.

Adverb of
Place

It tells us where
the action took
place.

Eg:- The deer follow
their mother
everywhere.

Adverb of
Time

It tells us
when the action
was done.

Eg:- She hurt her
foot yesterday.

Adverb of
Frequency

It tells us
how often an
action takes
place.

Eg:- My father
often goes on
tours.

Adverb
of Degree

It tells us the
extent to which
an action
happens.

Eg:- The ship
almost hit an
iceberg.

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
